**MEMBER:** 18<sup>th</sup> BATTALION – WOUNDED 29 AUGUST 1915 – SUFFERED GUN SHOT  
WOUNDS TO THIGH & HAND & BOMB WOUND TO LEG.  
TRANSFERRED BY HOSPITAL SHIP “MAHANO” TO MUDROS & THEN BY  
HOSPITAL SHIP “HUNTS GREEN” TO ENGLAND IN SEPTEMBER 1915.

**RETURNED:** RETURNED TO AUSTRALIA ON “STAR OF VICTORIA” 19 JANUARY 1916 &  
SUBSEQUENTLY DISCHARGED 23 OCTOBER 1916.

**RE-ENLISTED:** 30 APRIL 1918 & PROCEEDED TO ENGLAND UNTIL FEBRUARY 1919.

**LIFE:** AFTER RETURNING TO AUSTRALIA ROBERT JOHN GREGORY MARRIED  
UNA M. JONES @ MOSMAN IN 1926.  
FAMILY THEN MOVED TO TAMWORTH WHERE R.J. GREGORY WAS A  
STATIONER UNTIL HIS DEATH IN 1944
