ALEXANDRIA.

SERVICE: TRANSFERRED TO MARSEILLES MARCH 1916 & SAW ACTION IN
FRANCE UNTIL 27 JULY 1916 WHEN SUFFERED A GUN SHOT
WOUND TO HIS BACK & WAS HOSPITALISED IN ENGLAND.

RETURNED TO AUSTRALIA 21 JULY 1917 & DISCHARGED 18 MARCH 1918.
