SERVICE (2): EMBARKED 13 APRIL 1915 TO CAIRO & THEN TO GALLIPOLI 14 JUNE
1915 WHERE HE SUFFERED A SEVERE GUNSHOT WOUND TO RIGHT LEG AT
LONE PINE ON 12 AUGUST 1915. SHIPPED TO 15th GENERAL HOSPITAL,
ALEXANDRIA & THEN TO LONDON ON 13 SEPTEMBER 1915.

RETURNED TO ACTION IN EGYPT 1916 & WOUNDED AGAIN MAY 1917.

RETURNED TO AUSTRALIA 03 MARCH 1918 & DISCHARGED 14 FEBRUARY 1919.
