HAND, INDEX FINGER & LOST PART OF LITTLE FINGER RESULTING IN
HOSPITALISATION FOR FIVE WEEKS BEFORE RETURNING TO ACTION.

RETURNED: TO AUSTRALIA ON H.T. "BOORARA" 23 AUGUST 1917.

DISCHARGED: 09 OCTOBER 1917.
