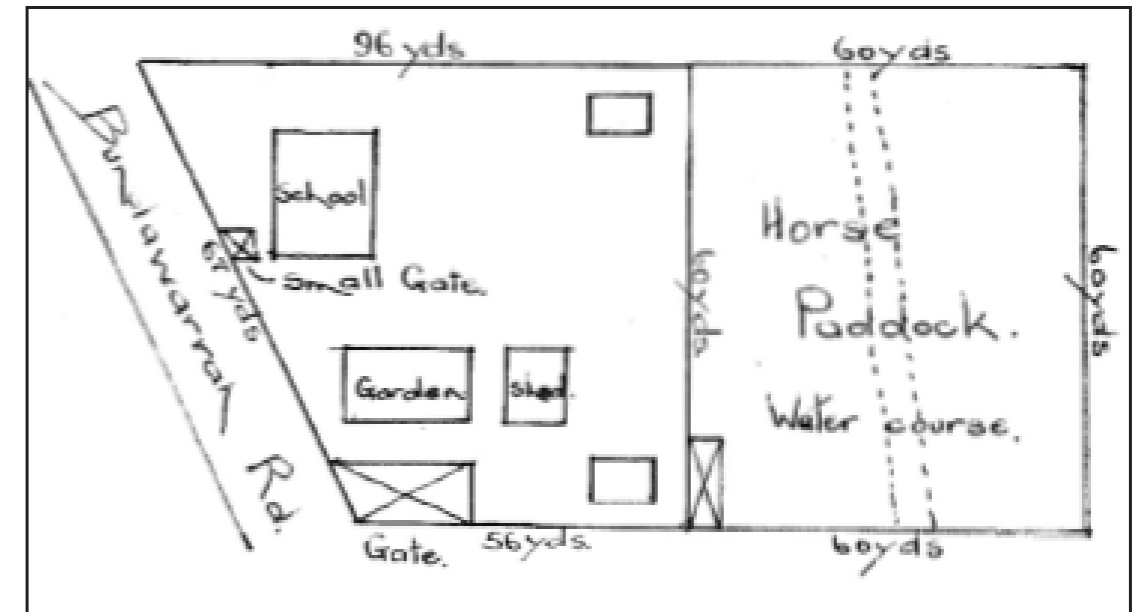


# BUNDAWARRAH SCHOOL

The Department of Public Instruction was petitioned for a school in May 1896, by the residents of the Bundawarra area. This original application was signed by JH Mallinson (2 children); E Raby (4); A Brabender (3); G Reinhold (1); J Sommerville (3); and M Hillier (5).

The Bundawarra school, located on the Bundawarra Road, five miles from Temora, was granted provisional status February 18, 1897, and opened in 1898. In January 1900, it became a public school. From 1913-1917, then from 1921-1923, and again from 1923-1926, Bundawarra operated as a subsidised school. It again achieved provisional status in November 1927.

The school closed in 1940, and the building was transferred to Sebastopol in 1943. It was eventually moved to the Temora Primary school. The teachers were:-
