

Stanleyville Provisional School 1910-1920

Stanleyville is listed as a Provisional School from November 1910—April 1920, but moved from Gundibindyal Road in June 1911 to a site seven miles east of Temora on the Stockinbingal Road. In the late 1920s the school was moved from this site to three miles east from Temora on the Old Cootamundra Road to be known as Wilna. Some of the early teachers were Miss Kay Keogh, Miss M Sheehan and Mrs Clarke.

Notable pupils were George White afterwards Rev. RG White and Max Brown.

An avenue of trees on the western boundary, were planted for the students who attended Stanleyville School and went to the WWI.
